

Homelessness Support

If your student is currently in a transitory living situation, s/he may qualify for services under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act.

The following situations qualify as transitory:

- Living with someone temporarily due to loss of housing/economic hardship (doubled-up)
- Living in a community shelter
- Living unsheltered (ex. on the streets, in a car, in an unfit building)
- Living in a hotel/motel due to lack of adequate alternatives
- Living without a parent/guardian (unaccompanied)

If your student is in one of the above situations, s/he has the right to receive support if any of the following needs arise:

- School supplies
- School transportation funding
- Referrals for medical attention, immunizations and other resources
- Clothing, toothpaste/toothbrush, and other basic needs

Your student's participation in the Education of Homeless Children and Youth Program is confidential.
